Directions to students

- Students only need to be in attendance at the College when they have a scheduled examination and for the Assembly period.
- All examinations are in **Room S9** (except Music Prac in S12 & Food Tech Prac M16 & Science Practical exams).
- Students are expected to be ready for the examination 10 minutes prior to the commencement time of the examination.
- No talking is permitted inside the examination room (unless directed to do so by the supervisor).
- No books, papers, etc may be taken into the examination room.
- **Reading Time** – is only for reading and **NO writing or highlighting** may be undertaken during reading time.
- **Mobile phones** are not permitted under any circumstances. If students do not wish to leave their phones in their bag then they are to be given to the supervising teacher at the **start** of the examination. Severe penalties will occur for those students who are found to have phones once the examination has started.
- Students are **not allowed to borrow** equipment once inside the examination room.
- Students are not permitted to leave the examination room until the scheduled time for the completion of the examination.
- Once the examination(s) has finished students who have finished for the day may leave. Leaving between examinations is NOT permitted.
